Oakland is and always has been a beer town; a place where hard-working people would gather together to enjoy locally brewed, fresh beer. As the local population grew during the Gold Rush and building of the Transcontinental Railway, Oakland was affectionately referred to as the “Milwaukee of the West” for its numerous neighborhood-based breweries. Oakland United Beerworks is a craft brewery in the heart of Oakland’s waterfront Jack London District and we are proud to continue the great beer brewing tradition in Oakland.

Founded in 2009 as Linden Street Brewery, we became the first community-based production brewery in Oakland since Golden West Brewery closed in the 1950s. In 2017, following the sale of our building on Linden Street to a new developer, we moved our operations to the waterfront Jack London District and rebranded as Oakland United Beerworks.

Under the stewardship of Head Brewer, Ian Powell, and with the support of a team of dedicated Oakland craft beer enthusiasts, Oakland United is proud to continue the great beer brewing tradition in Oakland.

Job Description and Requirements:

Oakland United Beerworks is currently looking to fill a part-time Delivery Driver position. Our Delivery Drivers deliver and rotate stock at assigned wholesale accounts in a timely, safe manner. Drivers will be responsible for interfacing with wholesale buyers and answering questions about our portfolio and inventory. Drivers will also deliver Direct to Consumer (DTC) online beer orders to local residents. Essential duties and responsibilities include:

- Safe operation of the vehicle and regular maintenance checks.
 - Perform and document daily and weekly safety inspection of the vehicle
 - Ensure that the vehicles are clean and safe when leaving the warehouse
 - Report immediately to Operations Lead any safety or mechanical issues.
 - Ensure that all vehicles are properly maintained and serviced
- Delivery of products and on premise sales materials to wholesale accounts.
- Delivery of Taproom transfers between the warehouse and the Taproom.
- Return of empty kegs from accounts.
- Inventory management at our warehouse location.
- Organization and scheduling of all wholesale and DTC online orders.

Required Skills and Abilities:

- Must be 21 years of age or older.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills- required for interactions with customers, vendors, and coworkers.
- Must be personable and have a positive attitude.
- Must be highly organized.
- Familiarity with Ekos (Preferred)
- Ability to operate and perform basic maintenance of a forklift and pallet jack.
- Must have a valid CA driver’s license with a clean driving record and reliable transportation.
- Ability to walk or stand for extended periods of time.
- Ability to lift up to 170lbs.
