Founded in 2009 as Linden Street Brewery, we became the first community-based production brewery in Oakland since Golden West Brewery closed in the 1950s. In 2017, following the sale of our building on Linden Street to a new developer, we moved our operations to the waterfront Jack London District and rebranded as Oakland United Beerworks.

Under the stewardship of Head Brewer, Mike Vinson, Brewer, Ralph Long, and with the support of a team of dedicated Oakland craft beer enthusiasts, Oakland United is proud to continue the great beer brewing tradition in Oakland.

Job Description and Requirements:

Oakland United Beerworks is currently looking to fill a part-time Delivery Driver/Cellar Person position. Our Delivery Drivers deliver and rotate stock at assigned wholesale accounts in a timely, safe manner. Drivers will be responsible for interfacing with wholesale buyers and answering questions about our portfolio and inventory. Essential duties and responsibilities include:

- Safe operation of the delivery van and regular maintenance checks. Ensure that the delivery van is properly maintained and serviced.
- Delivery of products and on-premise sales materials to wholesale accounts and to our South Bay sales rep.
- Delivery of Taproom transfers between the warehouse and the Taproom.
- Inventory management at our warehouse location.

In addition to all delivery and logistics responsibilities, this position will include work in our Brewhouse. You will be assisting the brewers with general operations in the brewhouse, which could include but is not limited to:

- Assistance on the canning line and kegging new products.
- Transferring materials between the warehouse location and the brewhouse location.
- Assistance with general sanitation and general brewhouse upkeep.

Required Skills and Abilities:

- Must be 21 years of age or older.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills- required for interactions with customers, vendors, and coworkers.
- Must be personable and have a positive attitude.
- Must be highly organized.
- Ability to operate and perform basic maintenance of a forklift and pallet jack. You will be forklift certified as part of your onboarding process.
- Must have a valid CA driver's license with a clean driving record and reliable transportation.
